The following list of modems has been tested extensively by 4-Sight and was found to be reliable and compatible with the version 7 solution. Even though modem technology is accelerating every day, the fastest any fax will transmit is the slower of the sending or receiving machine/modem. Today, the majority of fax machines in use worldwide transmits and receives between 9600 and 19200 baud. We recommend and provide the MultiTech fax modems as they have proven to be the most reliable of all models tested.
